

Biofilta Foodcubes have a deep soil profile and large water reservoir and are heavy when full. The total weight of the container, soil, water and plants of a single square Foodcube is up to 400 kilograms, which is the equivalent to the weight of 5 adults.

*Before you install Foodcubes on decks, rooftops, balconies or any other raised structure you must consult a qualified professional such as structural engineer to ensure the structure has the appropriate load bearing capacity and is structurally sound.

Please ensure they are installed away from fall zones where they could be used as climbing structures by children or pets. Check with local building regulations for safe distance.
